Whereas the National Associations or Professional Institutions for Landscape Architects in the then European Community agreed in April 1989 to form a European Foundation for Landscape Architecture (EFLA), thereafter renamed the 'European Federation for Landscape Architecture', and whereas this agreement was recorded in a Declaration signed by the authorised representatives of the said member Associations and Institutions which adopted principles and aims of the Federation as set out in Appendix 'A' of that Declaration.

Whereas the Declaration additionally accepted Appendix 'B', "Aims and Objectives for Landscape Architecture Education" and in accordance with Appendix 'C' agreed the recognition of academic qualifications awarded by listed courses in the signatory countries and by Appendix 'D' adopted model structures for undergraduate and masters' graduate and postgraduate courses as being representative of the minimum education requirements for the training of Landscape Architects.

Whereas in 2007 EFLA joined with the International Federation of Landscape Architects (IFLA) and now acts as the European Region of IFLA and so extended its full membership to national associations of landscape architects of member states of the Council of Europe and to states geographically within the Council of Europe.

Whereas the new Statutes of the Federation, as published in the Belgian official Journal *Le Moniteur Belge*, dated 25th April 1996, modified in part those published in the same Journal dated 4th October 1990, and those modified as published in the *Moniteur Belge* on 19th September 2006.

Having due regard to the aforementioned
